Since 2003, the SLF has funded over 1100 initiatives, partnering with more than 300 community-based organizations in the 15 sub-Saharan African countries hardest hit by the pandemic.

WHAT DOES THE MONEY DO?

The community-based organizations developed by and for the African grandmothers take a holistic approach as they resurrect lives torn apart by AIDS:

- Income generation such as community gardens and sewing school
- Home building for grandmothers caring for vulnerable children
- Home-based care, training on how to care for HIV positive family members
- Legal and human rights training around violence against women and property rights.
